

Syracuse Poster Project: Haiku Entries for Poetry Posters

To Contributors:

The 2020 poster series will consist of 15 posters on the usual theme of life in Central New York and one special poster on living healthy. You may enter up to three haiku for the usual theme and one haiku for the special poster. Submit haiku by writing them on the back of this agreement. For the traditional contest, write about downtown, the city at large, or the nearby countryside. Check for syllable count and punctuation. Then sign and return the agreement.

Entry deadline: first Friday in September.

- ☞ The poems have three lines of 5, 7, 5 syllables, no title lines. No poems that could be construed as advertising. For more help, see “Haiku Guidelines” in the “Participate” section of our web site: www.posterproject.org.
- ☞ The Project selects 150 top haiku to pass along for artists’ consideration. Each artist receives an allotment of haiku to consider. The Project will also select three semi-final haiku on the pleasures of living healthy in Central New York. The artist assigned to that poster will select the final haiku.
- ☞ In addition to the annual collection of 16 posters, the Project may produce other poetry-based products, such as booklets, cards, journals, etc.
- ☞ Independent artists create illustrated posters based on the haiku of their choice.
- ☞ The poet hereby grants to the Project a royalty-free right and license to create collective works and derivative works based on the poem in any media or format; and to reproduce, distribute, publicly read and publicly display the poem for the term of the copyright. The Project shall own all right, title and interest in and to the copyrights in any collective or derivative works. The poet shall retain all right, title and interest in the poem, and may therefore publish the poem in other publications.
- ☞ The Project notifies poets of selection in December. Posters go up in April.
- ☞ Each poet whose work results in a poster will receive two free 11x17” prints.
